Bob* is 78 and a client of two senior programs at Catholic Charities: Connections & Awareness for Elders (CAFE) and the RepPayee program. CAFE has volunteers who provide a connection to isolated older adults. Bob is a widower. The stress has left him unable to manage his bills and checks. The RepPayee program assists seniors in paying bills and managing their Social Security benefits. Bob started the service two years ago. He feels less stressed than ever now that he has someone to help him with his bills. In 2014, Catholic Charities agencies provided 1,630,321 client services that improved family economic security in 146 agencies across 52 states and territories.

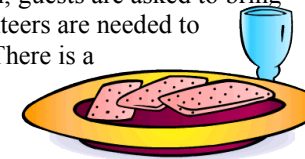

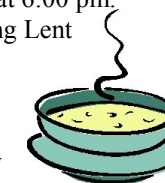
Lenten Fasting and Abstinence

The law of abstinence prohibits the eating of meat. *Fridays in Lent* are days of abstinence. The obligation of abstinence begins at age 14. The law of fasting allows one full meal and two smaller ones. The law of fasting obliges all between the ages of 18-59. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence.

Stations of the Cross will be this Friday at 6:00 pm. There will be a Soup Supper each Friday during Lent following Stations:
